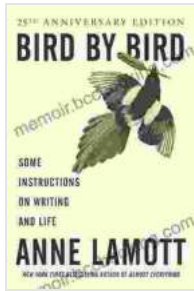
Author / Source	Works Cited Entry Guidelines	Example(s)
1 author	Author Last Name, First Name List first and middle name(s) as initials if that's how the source displays them.	Patterson, James Rowling, J. K. King, Laurie R.
2 authors	1 st Author Last Name, First Name and Full Name of 2 nd Author.	Shields, David, and Caleb Power.
3+ authors	1 st Author Last Name, First Name, et al. * "et al." means "and others."	Beck, Isabel L., et al.
Editor(s)	Add a comma after the name(s) and the word "editor" or "editors."	Kensaker, Tej Ratna, and Mark Turin, editors.
Film or TV Show	List the person whose contributions you are focusing on. Add a comma after the name(s) and indicate their title.	Byrne, Rose, performer. Burton, Tim, director.
Translated work	Use the translator as the author. Include the name of the original creator after the title, preceded by the word "By".	Rojas, Carlos, translator. <i>The Four Books</i> . By Yasu Kanki.
Pseudonyms (3 options)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> List the author's more well-known name. List the more well-known name in brackets. List the well-known name, followed by the published as name in brackets. 	King, Stephen. (King, Stephen). King, Stephen (<i>published as Richard Bachman</i>).
Organization, author only	Use the full name of the organization as the author.	The New York City Department of Education.
Organization as both author and publisher	Omit the author. Start the citation with the source title. List the organization as the publisher.	<i>MLA Handbook</i> .
Social media	If known, start with the author's real name. Then the username in brackets. If the real name and username are similar, just use the real name.	Obama, Barack Chegg Nielsen, Lisa (@InnovativeEdu)
No author	Start the citation with the title. Depending on the container, the title will either be italicized (e.g., books, art, etc.) or in quotation marks (e.g., articles, songs, etc.).	<i>The Epic of Gilgamesh</i> . "Dog Saves Cat During Flood."

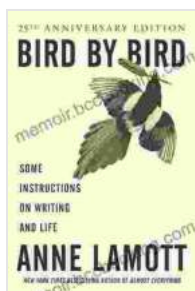
